To annually recognize churches that provide outstanding scouting/youth mentoring ministry to their communities through sponsorship of one or more of the following civic youth-serving agencies: Boy Scouts of America (BSA), Girl Scouts of the USA (GSUSA), Camp Fire USA (CFUSA), 4-H, and/or Big Brothers Big Sisters of America (BBBS). These churches welcome all youth and children; nurture them as they grow to become good citizens with a deeper relationship with God; and work with them in service to others.

CRITERIA

- 1. Sponsor one or more of the following groups: BSA, GSUSA, CFUSA, 4-H and/or BBBS to meet the needs of youth and children in the congregation and in the community. The 2012 Book of Discipline (¶256.4a) encourages churches to have signed partnership agreements.
- 2. Offer and encourage participation in the PRAY awards, a religious education program for youth and children, grades 1-12 (2012 Book of Discipline ¶256.4). For more information visit Programs of Religious Activities with Youth (www.praypub.org).
- 3. Observe a Scouting Ministries Sunday or conduct a separate Sunday service for each group.
- 4. Encourage each troop/group in the church to annually participate in at least one community service project. Service projects benefiting and in cooperation with the sponsoring church are encouraged.
- 5. Elect or appoint a scouting coordinator who reports regularly to the governing body of the local church (2012 Book of Discipline ¶253).
