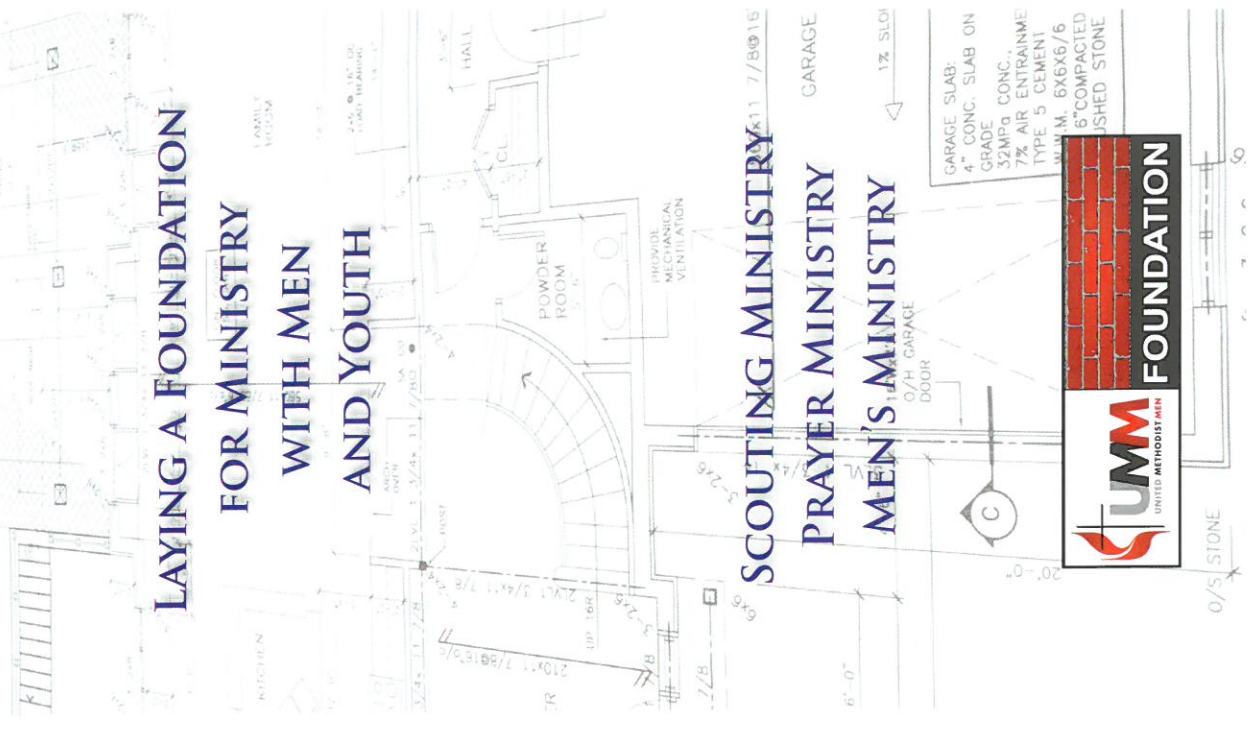

MISSION STATEMENT

To provide financial support for evangelism, mission and spiritual life ministries to men and youth in the United Methodist Church through endowed funds.

VISION STATEMENT

To provide endowed support for United Methodist Men's ministries in order to declare the centrality of Christ in every man's life.

ENDOWMENT

In 1981, the United Methodist Men Foundation was established by the National Association of Conference Presidents of United Methodist Men as a way to support scouting ministry when it appeared the denomination was no longer willing to do so.

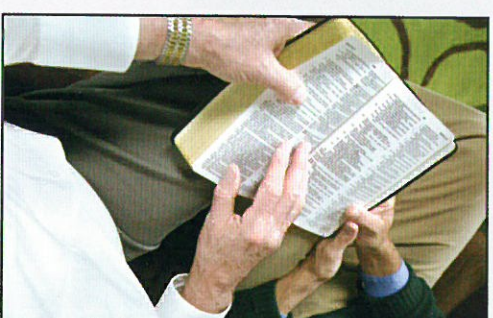
The foundation later added programs to deepen the spiritual life of men across the church through evangelism, mission, and spiritual life.

In today's society, conventional means of funding have become more and more challenging to secure. The church is no exception to this problem. World Service apportionments are stretched to the limit and requests for financial support of church outreach programs are growing.

Endowments enable the United Methodist Men Foundation to fund men's ministries in perpetuity. Currently there are three endowment programs supported by the United Methodist Men Foundation:

SCOUTING MINISTRY • PRAYER MINISTRY • MEN'S MINISTRY

SCOUTING - The foundation partially funds the Office of Civic Youth-Serving Agencies/Scouting Ministries, led by a full-time professional to promote the growth of scouting in local churches. This ministry is accomplished through Boy Scouts of America, Girl Scouts of the U.S.A., Camp Fire USA, and Big Brothers Big Sisters.



Each year over 550,000 young people and their families are served by the United Methodist churches through these youth programs. Over half of these families are unchurched, representing a tremendous outreach and evangelism opportunity for local churches.

PRAYER - Thousands of calls requesting prayer are received by the Upper Room Prayer Line each year. United Methodist Men have made it possible for the prayer center to operate on a 24-hour basis with trained personnel.
