CLERGY APPRECIATION PROGRAM

This program is designed for United Methodist Men to express appreciation to the clergy of the local church. This may be done on a district wide basis, an annual conference basis, and clusters of churches or in individual churches.

This event may be held in a fellowship hall, hotel ballroom or other appropriate setting. It is recommended that the men who are sponsoring the event pay for the meals of all clergy invited. Ideally, the program also includes all members of the clergy persons' families. You are encouraged to invite spouses to accompany each clergy person, paying for their meal if possible.

This program may also be a picnic, barbecue, or dessert social. Local church lay leaders, as well as district lay leaders should be invited to the event. It is recommended that the district superintendent also be invited to bring greetings and/or the message. The local committee working closely with the district UMMen president can determine who else should be in attendance.
